2. Call for New Community Council Members

Residents are encouraged to consider joining the CWNCC next year when the opportunity arises to self nominate. It is a vital link between the local community and the Highland Council. The key dates are as follows:

- Monday 15th January to Tuesday 30th January Submission of CC Nominations
- Wednesday 31st January Publication of CC Nomination Results
- Tuesday 6th February Latest date for withdrawal of CC nomination

Details of how to self nominate are on the CWNCC website with a link to the relevant Highland Council page, and nominees simply require their **voters roll number**, which is easily obtained from the Highland Council. CC Members can be aged from 16 years and junior members can use this experience as part of their personal development or towards their Saltire volunteer award.

3. Snow Plough and Gritter update

At the last CC meeting, it was agreed that an application should be made to the Winds of Change for a gritter and snow plough to assist with clearing the pavement from the Cawdor Shop to the school. As the Community Council were unable to conduct business, the West Nairnshire Safer Paths group submitted the application and took ownership of the equipment last week. The ownership will transfer over to CWNCC at the earliest opportunity next year. Cawdor Estate agreed to operate and maintain the equipment, during term time, for the first winter season.

4. Coronation Tree for Cawdor

A ceremony took place on Tuesday 28th November at the Jubilee Wood with the Lord Lieutenant, who selected Cawdor as the site for the Nairn County tree in respect of the community effort with the Big Cawdor Picnic. Lord Cawdor chose a Horse Chestnut tree as a symbol of endurance and the planting was assisted by local volunteers and pupils from Cawdor Primary School.

6. Highland Council - Cllr Babs Jarvie

Cllr Babs Jarvie gave an update of relevant Highland Council items:

- The Howford Bridge road improvements are complete. Thanks were given to Joanna McGregor for raising the issue of the steep drop to the river. There is now a barrier giving protection on that side of the road.
- Auldearn new traffic calming measures interesting to see the impact on traffic
- Abandoned caravan removed from entrance to Dallaschyle Wood
- Pothole at Scottish Water drain cover in Clephanton repaired
- Speed signs at Clephanton, which are not clear, have been reported
- Dava Bridge repairs just gone out to tender
- Haventus, Port of Ardersier, meeting scope for potential job opportunities for local school leavers
- Nairn Academy planning application just submitted. Next stakeholder meeting in February 2024
- Climate Cafe run by Green Hive Funding available for Active Travel routes, linking paths from Forres to Nairnshire/Cawdor
- Wheels In Nairnshire looking for volunteer drivers mini bus or own transport
- Team Hamish Phase 2 new seating and improved paths at the putting green in Nairn - starting March 2024
- New waste bins to improve household recycling coming next year
- Consultation for Scheme of Establishment of Community Council January 2024
- 20 mph rollout Comments to be submitted to the Highland Council via website
- The Brae in Nairn public consultation re pedestrianising the brae
- Local Place Plan there is now a coordinator, Kenny Spink, overseeing the public consultation
- Nairn & Nairnshire Community Partnership new Police representative in charge, focusing on key local representatives, which should see improved communication.
